



**Green jobs** (green-collar jobs, sustainability jobs, eco jobs or environmental jobs) are, according to the United Nations Environment Program, "work in agricultural, manufacturing, research and development (R&D), administrative, and service activities that contribute(s) substantially to preserving or restoring environmental quality.

Specifically, but not exclusively, this includes jobs that help to protect ecosystems and biodiversity; reduce energy, materials, and water consumption through high efficiency strategies; de-carbonize the economy; and minimize or altogether avoid generation of all forms of waste and pollution." The environmental sector has the dual benefit of mitigating environmental challenges as well as helping economic growth.

- EU CBC (cross-border cooperation) funded project PAN Phenomena of the Arctic Nature is coming to an end.
- ad hoc Advisory Board and transboundary working group established – to continue TB cooperation and implementation of chosen actions in the 10-year Action plan.

- Letter for postponement for re-evaluation of EUROPARC Transboundary Parks' certificate.




## Results from PAN – project

- New services and infrastructure like Visitor point Gjøken to Øvre Pasvik National Park (NO)
  - Old buildings renovated for the new concept by local specialized carpenters
  - Outdoor exhibition, place for events and guiding
- Networking (NO & FI) between
  - Visitor centres, which are kind of windows to the protected areas and sights as such
  - tourism companies and managers of protected areas in workshops for concepting new services to sustainable nature-based tourism


